Line Cooks perform some or all of the following duties:

- **Station Set Up.** The line cook is responsible for preparing his or her station before the start of each service. Line cook stocks his/her line before leaving for the day. Filling the station. Doing quality check of all the food items before lunch or dinner service, taking temperature checks every 3 hours to make sure food is safe from bacterial growth.
- **Prepping Food.** The line prepares food items, portions them, and performs all the duties to get the food ready before services. This means chopping vegetables, butchering meat, or preparing sauces strictly as per recipe provided.
- **Cooking.** During meal service, the line cook is responsible for preparing the items requested from his or her station. Special meals and allergic meals to prepare as per order. All recipes must be followed and dishes plated as per guidelines.
- **Clean Up.** At the end of service, the line cook is responsible for cleaning his or her station or entire kitchen, and may be asked to help other cooks clean up their stations. May do dishes, wash pots and other kitchen utensils. Sweeping and Mopping the floor, wiping walls and kitchen equipments etc.
- **Chef's Order.** Doing all other job duties as requested by Chef or Manager On Duty like Counting monthly inventories, stocking deliveries, organizing supplies, arranging kitchen, extra cleaning duties and another things as requested.
- **Food Safety Certification.** Candidate must pass Saskatchewan Food Safety Certificate in first three months after arriving to Canada.
